Production Notes

We recorded our first tasting notes of the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon components in July of 2020. We recorded 16 additional tastings involving these components or blends of these components to arrive at our final blend for 2019! Aged 23 months in 20% new French oak. 1850 cases produced.

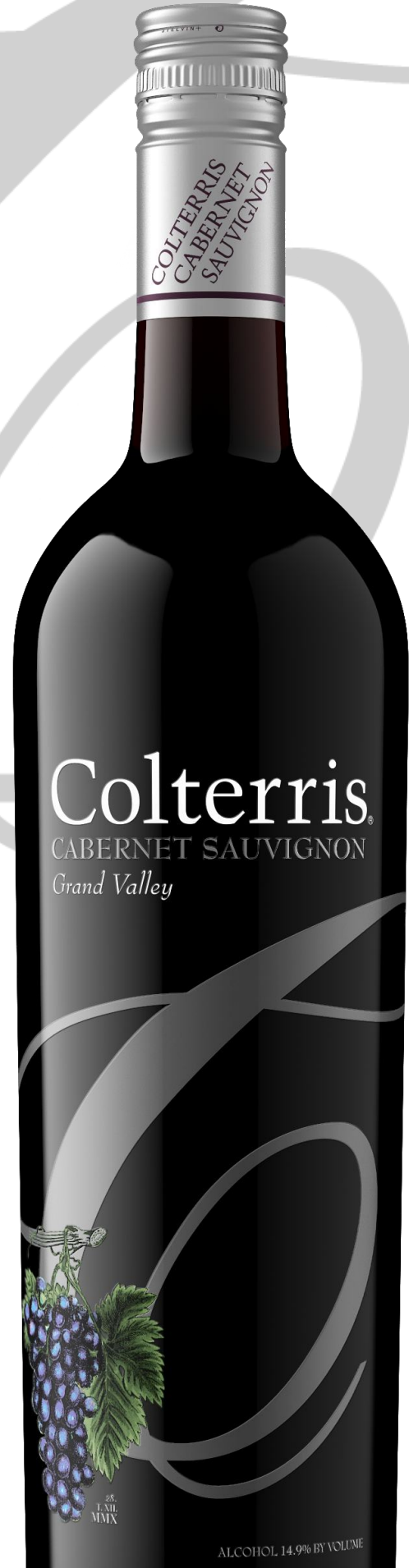

Winemaker's Notes

In keeping with tradition, this Cabernet Sauvignon is very fruit forward and expressive of both dark and red fruit notes. On the palate, the wine is bold, with layers of sweet fruit and subtle notes of coffee and leather. Like most of our red wines, the tannins add a nice textural element without being overwhelming.
