Winemaker's Notes

This three varietal Estate Selection Bordeaux blend is rich and luscious, with wonderful fruitful presence in the glass and on the palate. The wine has structured yet well-integrated tannins that add a nice textural balance. On the palate, the wine shows both fresh and concentrated fruit notes, a subtle acid component, and deliciously drinkable opulence!
