The 2019 Grand Valley Merlot has a great balance of fruit and chocolate in the glass, reminiscent of a dark chocolate raspberry truffle. On the palate, this wine has volume and juicy fruit character. As always, the tannins are present, but not over the top and add just the perfect amount of texture to the palate.
