### Production Notes

The 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon marks a return to a single-varietal expression, with no blending components used in this vintage. Fermentation and cap management emphasize maintaining varietal character while building structure but preserving balance. After primary fermentation, the young wine was racked into 20% new French oak barrels and allowed to age for 20 months. The balance was aged in neutral oak barrels which helps preserve focus on fruit and place. Bottled 8/16-17/2022. 996 cases produced.



### Tasting Notes

The 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon's deep garnet color is truly eye catching as it moves in the glass. Immediate black currants and dark fruits followed by leather and truffle accents bring to mind excellent seasoned meat pairings. As the wine opens in the glass, very subtle floral notes can be found such as acacia or hawthorn.
