Production Notes

Petit Verdot continues to be a varietal with very few examples to enjoy. For being such a robust and beautiful wine, it's hard to understand why more focus hasn't been put on this varietal! Aged 20 months in 25% new French oak, balance in previously used barrels. Bottled 8/23/2022. 557 cases produced.

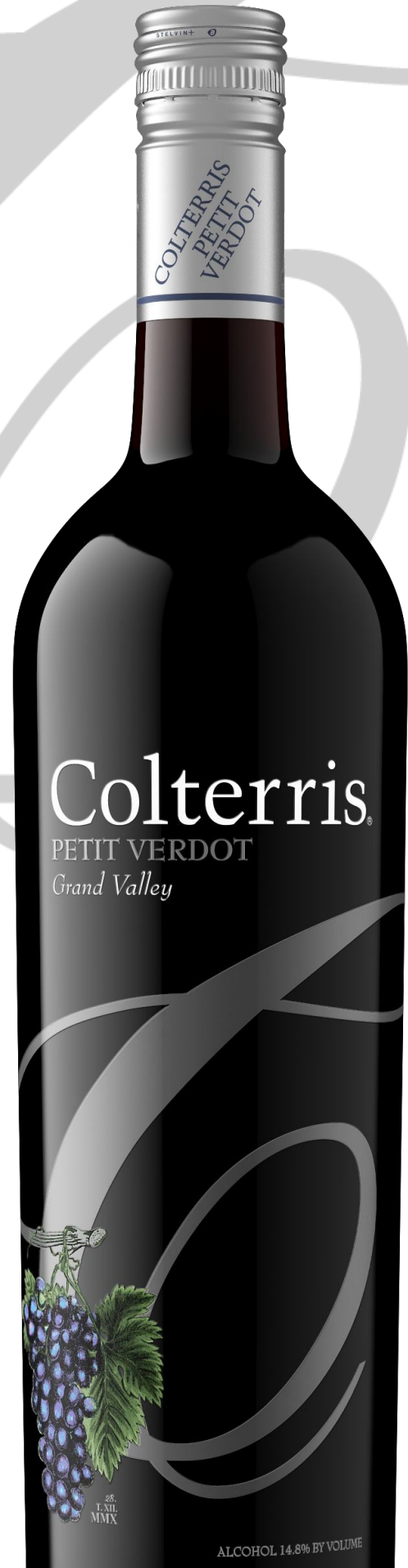

Winemaker's Notes

The 2020 Grand Valley Petit Verdot is a rich, robust, and full-bodied red wine. The aromatic profile shows great fruit notes, violet floral notes and a touch of wild sage. On the palate, the wine delivers layers of flavor with concentrated dark cherry and blackberry. With smaller berries and thicker Colorado skins, the tannins are present but well integrated and linger through the finish. Pair with rich, aged cheeses, earthy root vegetables, beef stews, game meats, and dark chocolate.
