Production Notes

John's Vineyard Merlot has bright red fruit notes and a great acid profile that does not have too much tannin. Using this Merlot as our blending partner helps take a little edge off the tannin while also driving more red fruit character in the glass. Aged 18 months in 10% new French oak barrels.
