Production Notes

An exciting moment in the history of Colterris, as this represents the first non-estate wine produced in our production space. The Horse Mountain Riesling grapes ripen slowly but retain acidity throughout the ripening curve. This slow maturation makes Riesling by far the last white wine into the winery. 399 cases produced.

Winemaker's Notes

In typical Riesling form, this wine shows intense aromatics with floral notes and stone fruit. On the palate, the wine has just a touch of residual sugar that helps drive ripe stone fruit notes. Refreshing acidity brings the wine to a nice, crisp finish.
