Production Notes

The 2023 Grand Valley Petit Verdot is produced from 100% estate-grown Petit Verdot grown in two distinct Grand Valley vineyard sites. Both lots were harvested and fermented separately to allow each small lot to show its true expression prior to any blending. During the fermentation process, the wines were pumped over twice per day in the early stages then lowered to once per day near the end. This careful management of extraction preserves balance while still allowing the varietal's depth and intensity to develop. After fermentation, the wines were aged for 19 months in all French oak barrels, 11% new, before undergoing a rigorous evaluation and blending process to determine the final blend. The finished wine is bold and voluptuous with generous fruit concentration and a distinctive floral note. Bottled 9/8/2025. 454 cases produced.



Tasting Notes

Vibrant deep ruby with purple edges. Nose opens with pomegranate, blackberry coulis, candied violet, fresh mint, and white pepper. Palate delivers juicy candied plum, blueberry, roasted mocha, and soft baking spices. Balanced tannins and lively acidity create a plush yet structured sip with a lingering herbal edge.
