Starting in vintage year 2022, John's vineyard has produced enough grapes to contribute to the Grand Valley Sauvignon Blanc. Planted to clone 530, John's Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc has been an incredibly aromatic component, producing wines in more of a Napa Valley style. Paired with Cliffside Vineyard, this vineyard site has really helped level up our Sauvignon Blanc quality and it's only just getting started! Bottled 1/17/2024. 759 cases produced.
